Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Daily circle time and enjoying ginger bear activities. Exploring large floor jigsaws together and taking turns.

Communication and Language

Home corner, Mud Kitchen and outside role play areas. Language associated with the castle and small world kings, queens and knights.

Knowledge and Understanding

Taking part in Welly Wednesday activities and exploring winter weather. Continuing to find out about special places in RE.

Physical Development

Testing our fine motor skills by using a magnet to put the correct number of sprinkles on the ice cream jigsaw. Using scarves to form large letter shapes in the air.

Week 3

Expressive Arts and Design

Continuing learning how to sew with a needle and thread in order to make pouches for a king or queen.

Maths

Exploring weight and recognising which items are heavier, lighter than and equal to another. Using cubes to balance an object and recording findings. Exploring capacity.

Reading and Writing

Continuing to learn Phase 1 Phonics for Nursery and Phase 3 for reception. Practising learning letter names and sounds and reading words with these sounds in. Reading, 'The King's Hats.' Looking at rhyming words and creating our own.
