Re: SIAMS Report

We are happy to be able to share our Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools (SIAMS) inspection report with you!

The Inspection Framework

The current SIAMS inspection framework is different to previous frameworks, which used to grade schools with single-word judgements, such as 'outstanding', which was our school's previous grading. The new framework explores ways in which: "the school's theologically rooted Christian vision drives its work and enables the school to live up to its foundation as a Church school. It focuses on the impact of the Church school's Christian vision on pupils and adults. This involves looking at the school's Christian vision, the provision the school makes because of this vision and how effective this provision is in enabling all pupils to flourish."

Inspectors make one of two judgements:

- The inspection findings indicate that the school is living up to its foundation as a Church school, and is enabling pupils and adults to flourish (J1).

Or

- The inspection findings indicate that the school has strengths, but that there are also issues that leaders need to address as a matter of priority (J2).

The Inspection Outcome

I am delighted to say that the school has been awarded the top grading, 'J1'. The report highlights the school's many strengths and is a testament to the way we work together to fulfil our vision and values and provide a school where children can 'flourish'. The governors, staff and I are delighted with the outcome. The whole community - pupils, parents, staff, governors, the church, friends and advisors from York Diocese and the Local Authority - have all played an important role in securing a fantastic judgement and report we can all feel proud of. I hope you enjoy reading it – it really is an affirming and positive read. Well done and thank you to all!
