This forms part of 'Creativity Week', a welcome new initiative coordinated by East Riding's Cultural Education Partnership, celebrating creativity and providing new opportunities for children and young people.

Digital resources have been made available to schools, including theatrical performances, talks with well-known musicians, artists and curators to provide inspiration and share new skills throughout the week. We have seen some fantastic creative work so far from children in both classed, with more to come, and we will be running our own photography challenge, inspired by Creativity Week, over the half term break – details will follow later this week.
